RECIPE | 3-STEP MINI CHEESECAKES

A-gi-yo-si (ha) (I'm Hungry), the Cherokee Nation Dietitian's Cookbook

Ingredients:

- 2 pkgs (8 oz) fat free cream cheese
- 1/2 cup sugar or sugar substitute
- 1/2 tsp vanilla
- 2 eggs
- 12 vanilla wafers or chocolate sandwich cookies
- Muffin Cups

Steps:

1. Mix cream cheese, sugar, and vanilla with an electric mixer on medium speed until well blended. Add eggs; mix until blended.
2. Place cookie on the bottom of each of the 12 paper-lined muffin cups. Pour batter evenly into muffin cups.
3. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes or until centers are almost set. Cool Refrigerate 3 hours or overnight. Garnish with fresh fruit or pie filling.
